

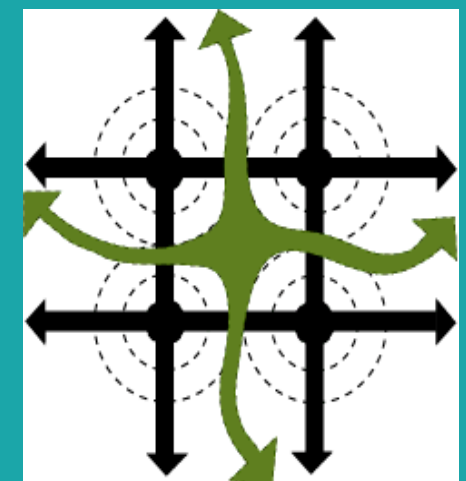
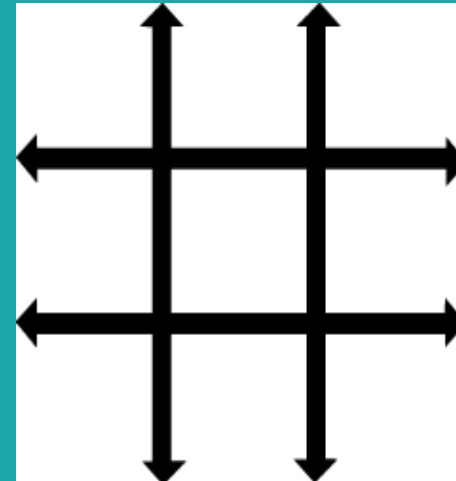
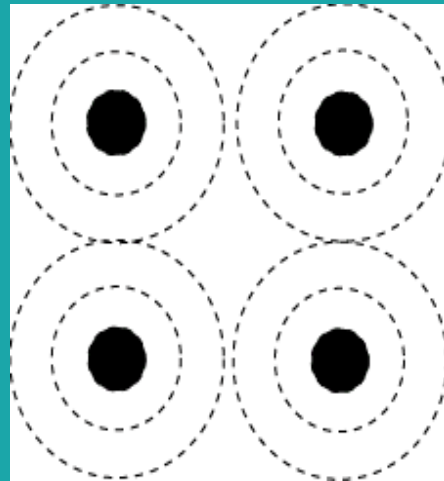

- Build a Healthy Economy



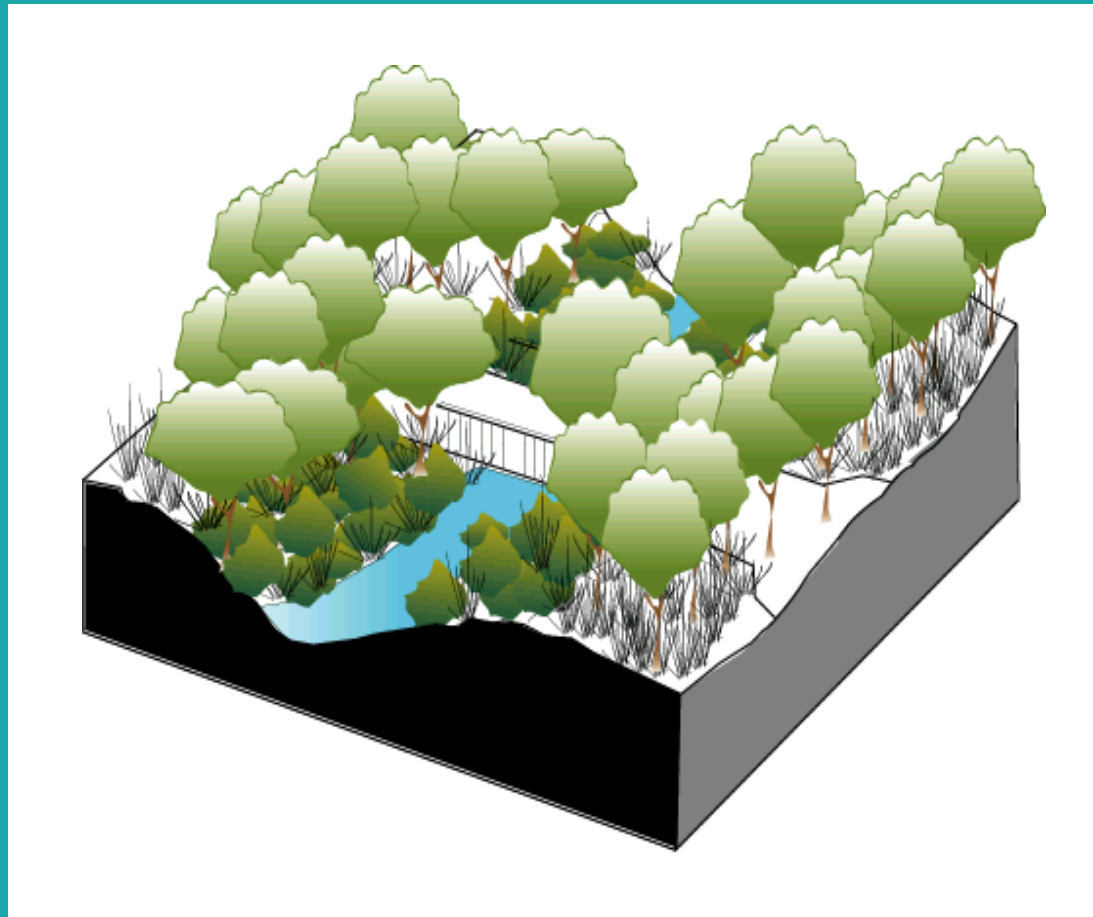
